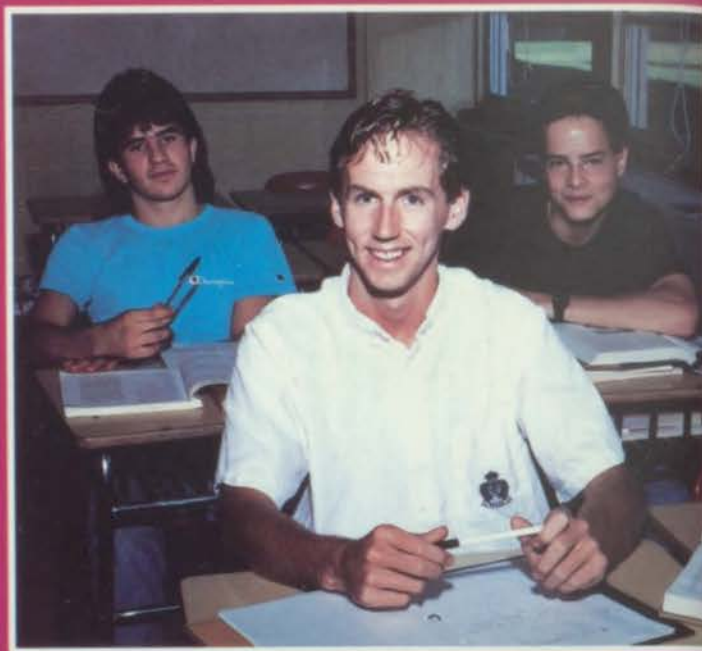
FUTURE PATHS

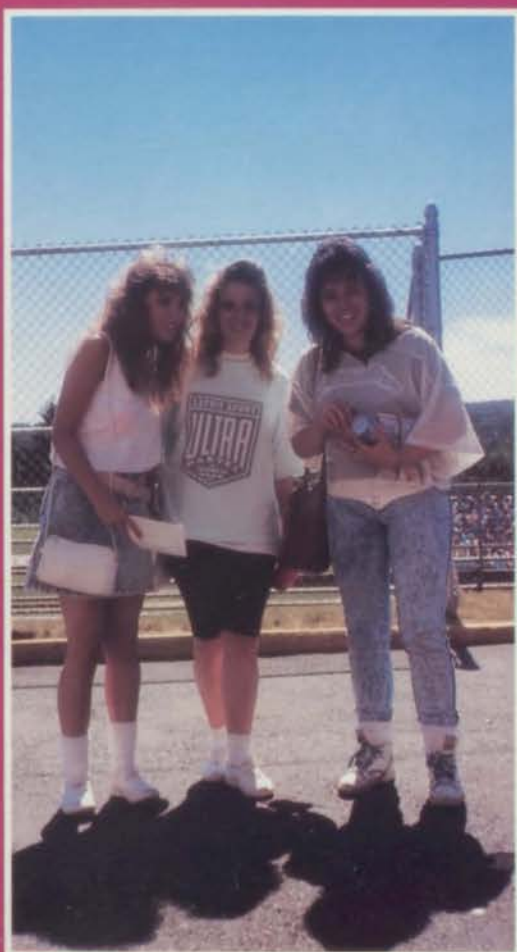
We all travel on the same path

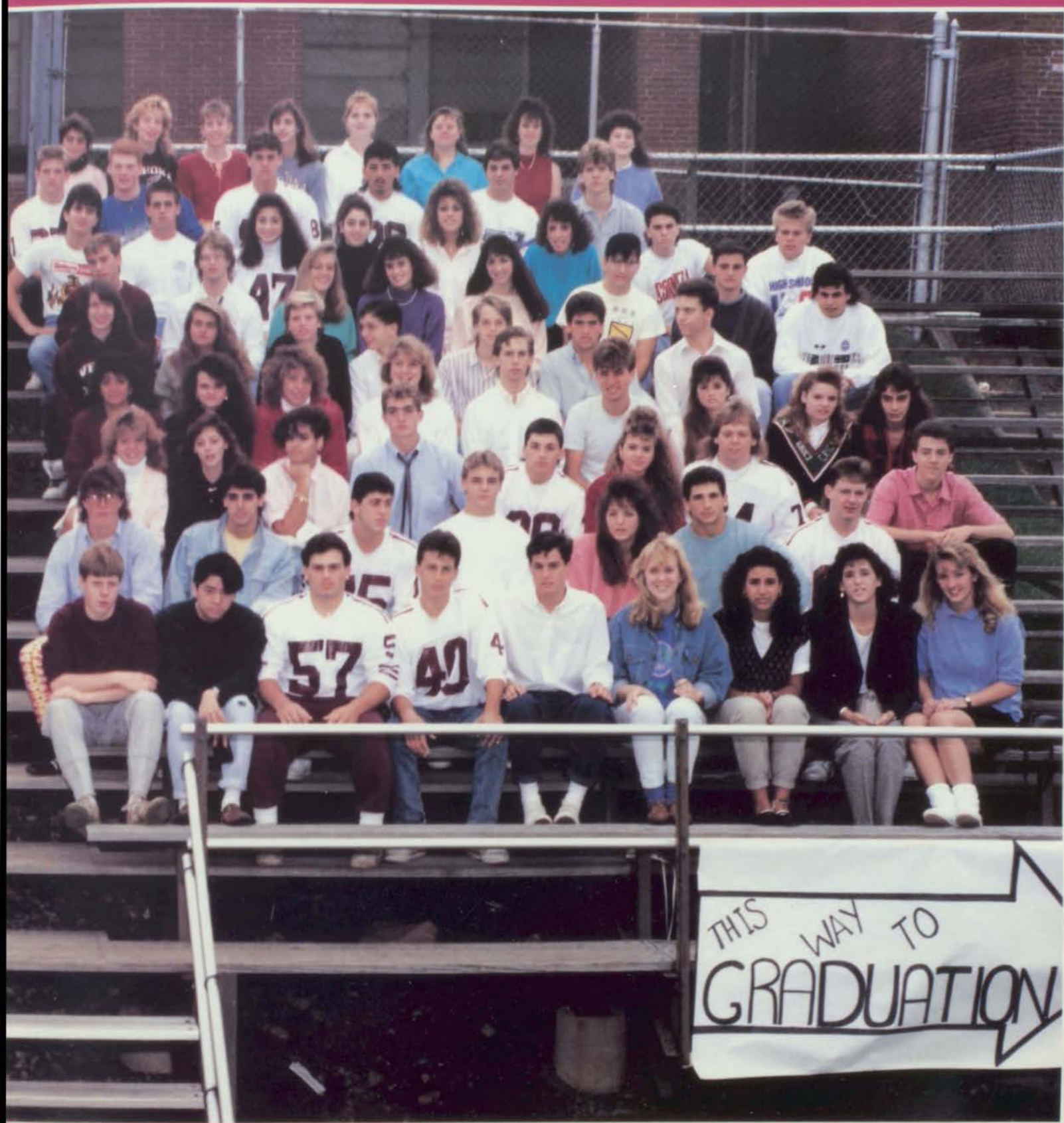


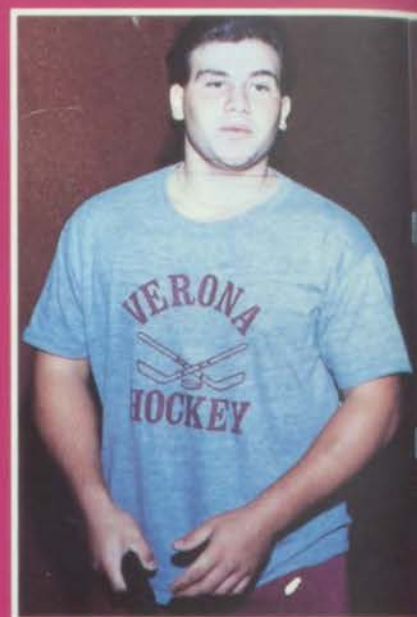






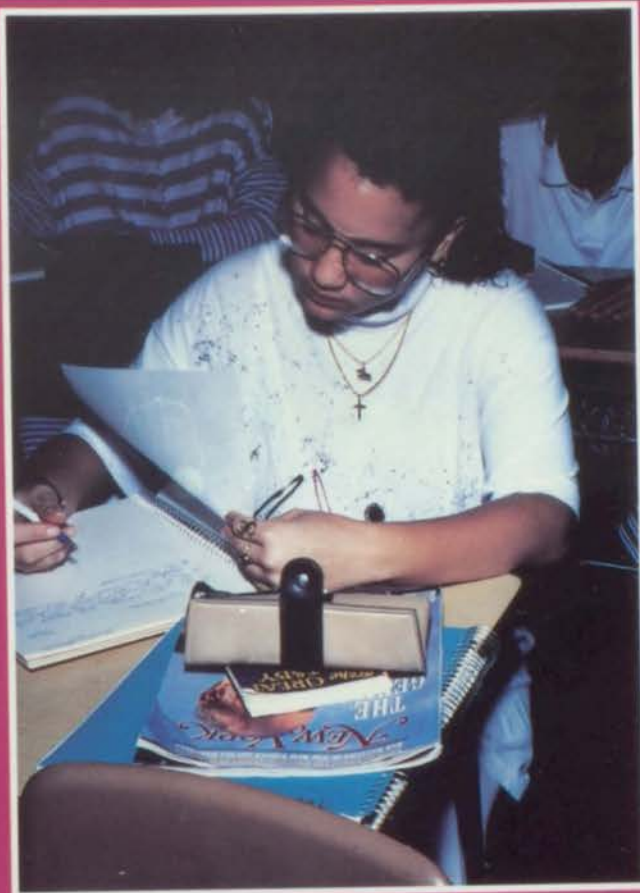
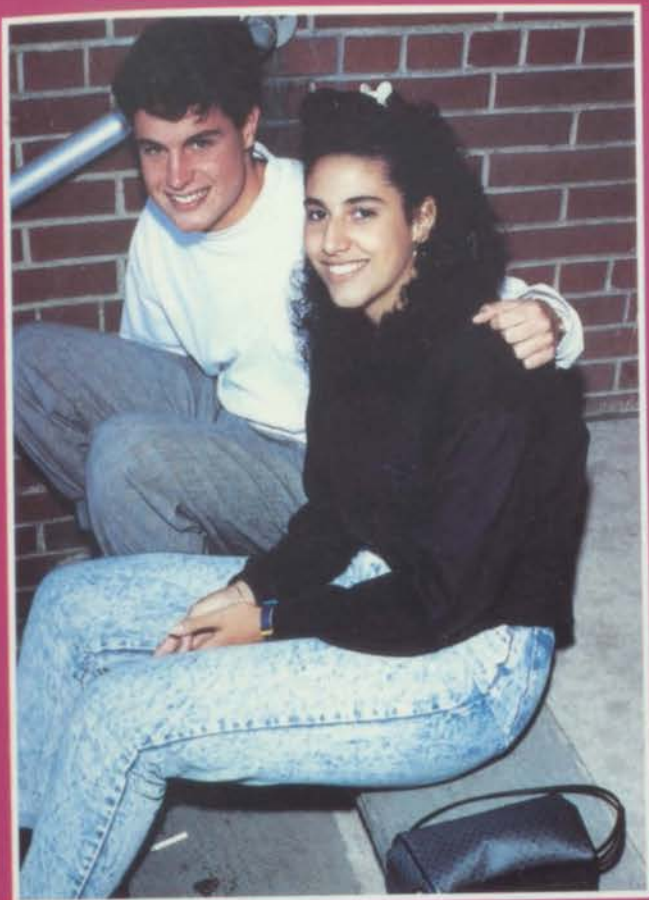




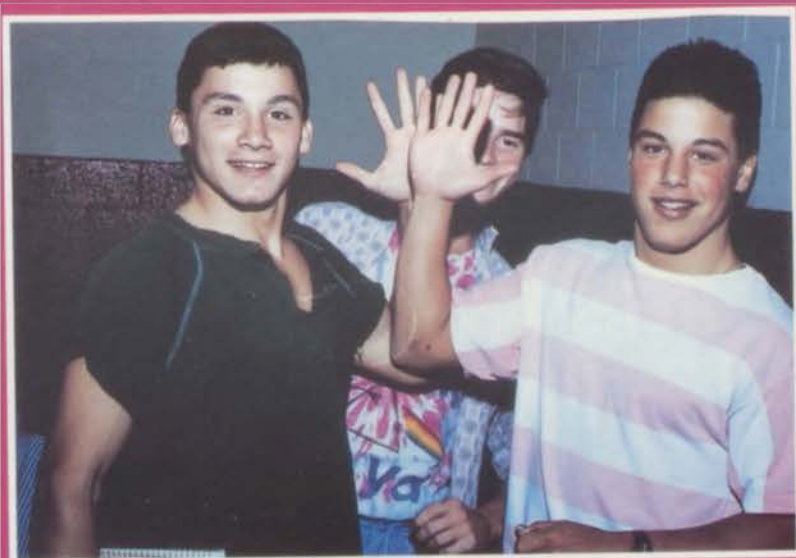






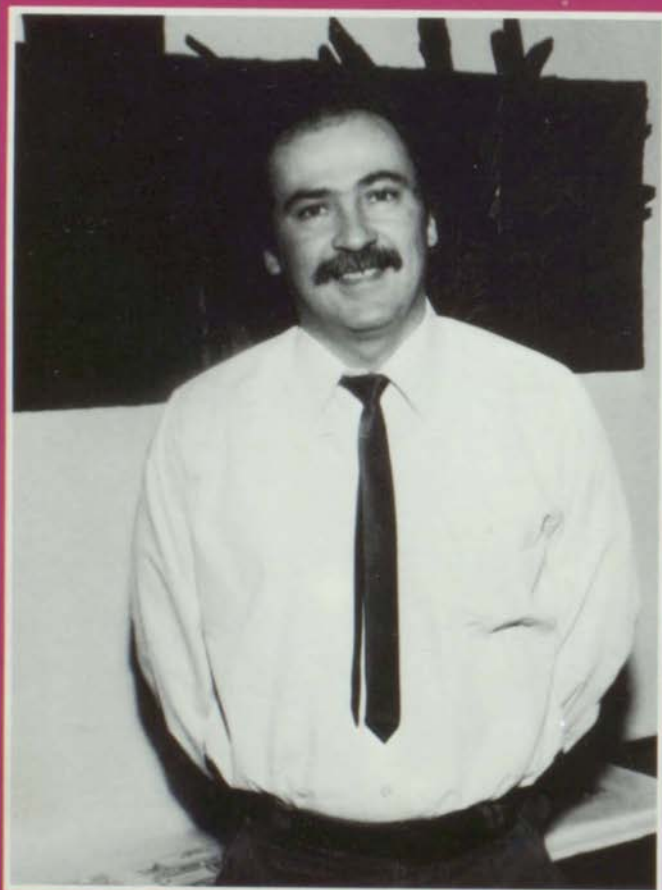


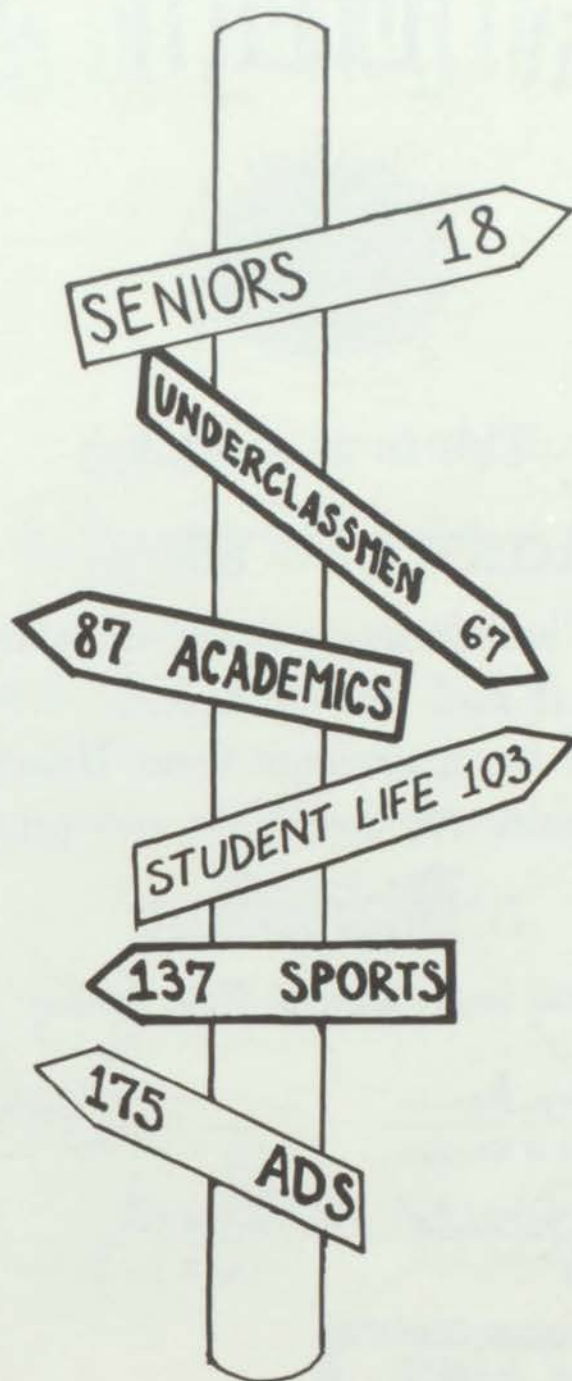




Dedication: Jim Sauer

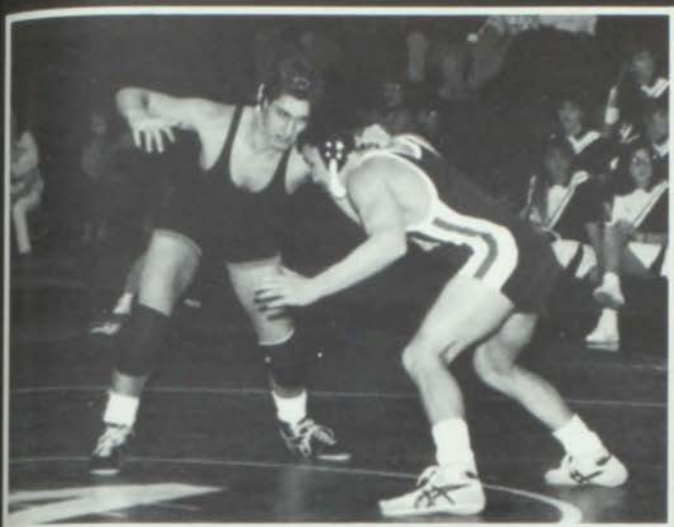

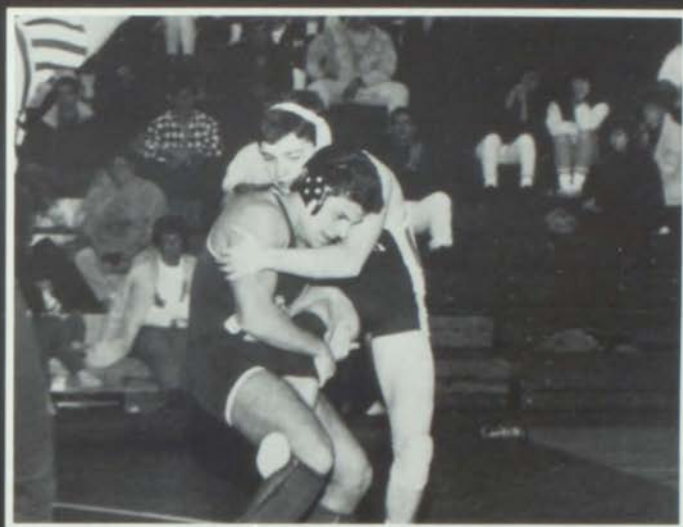

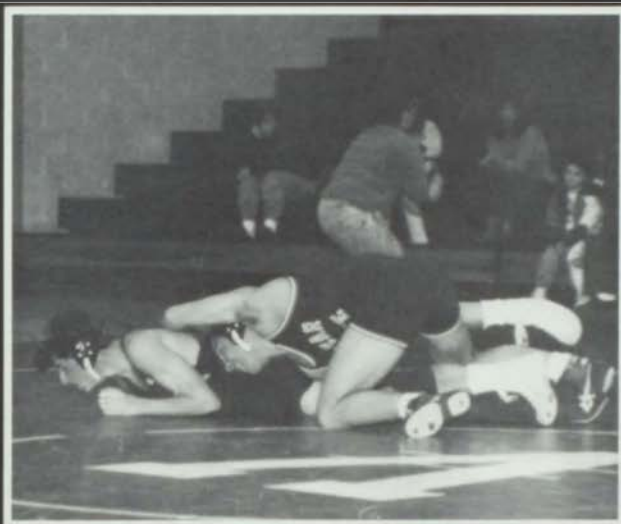

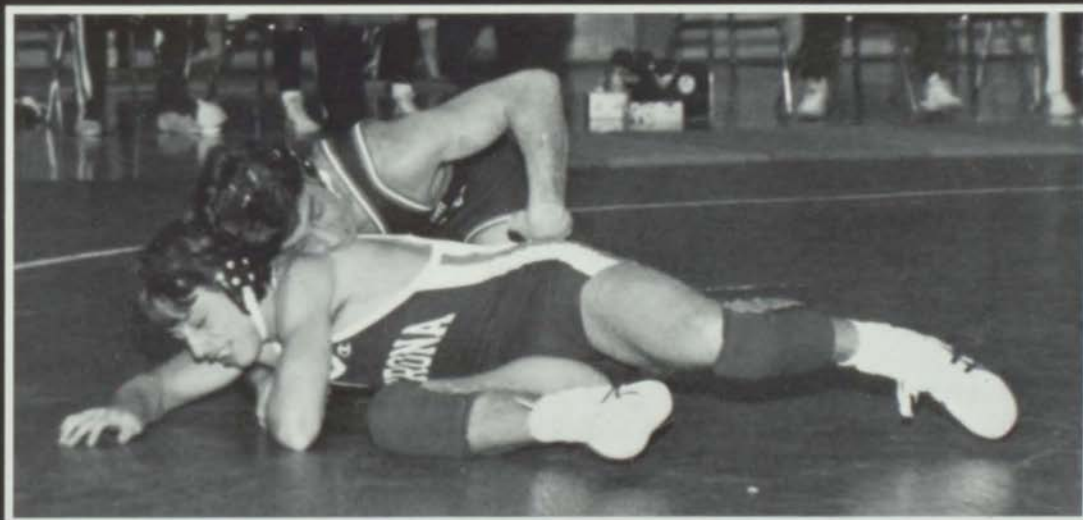

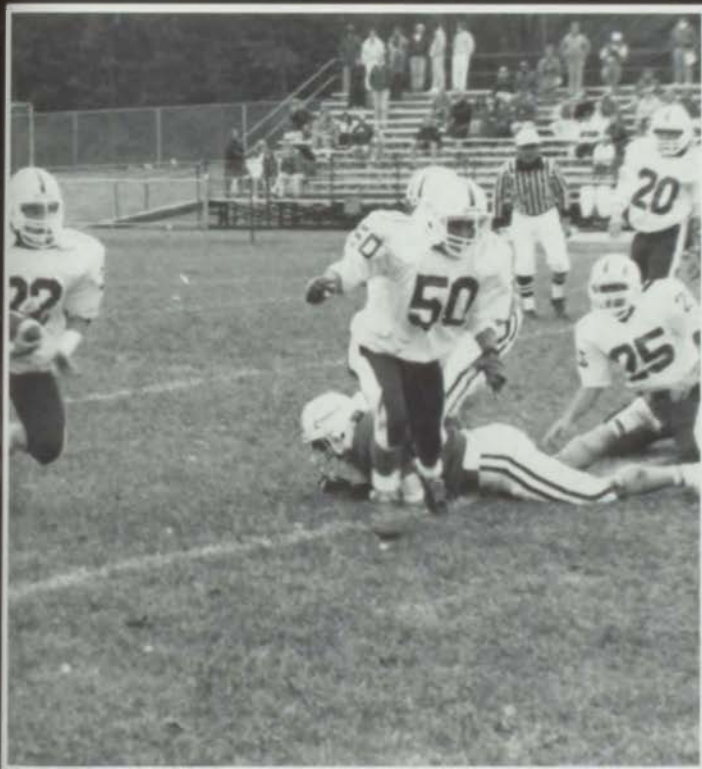
