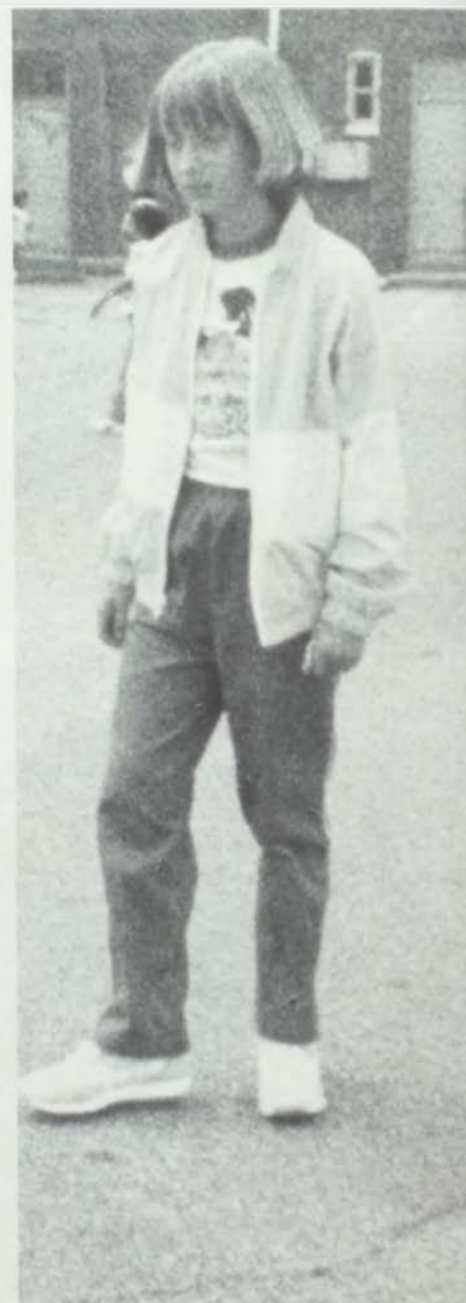

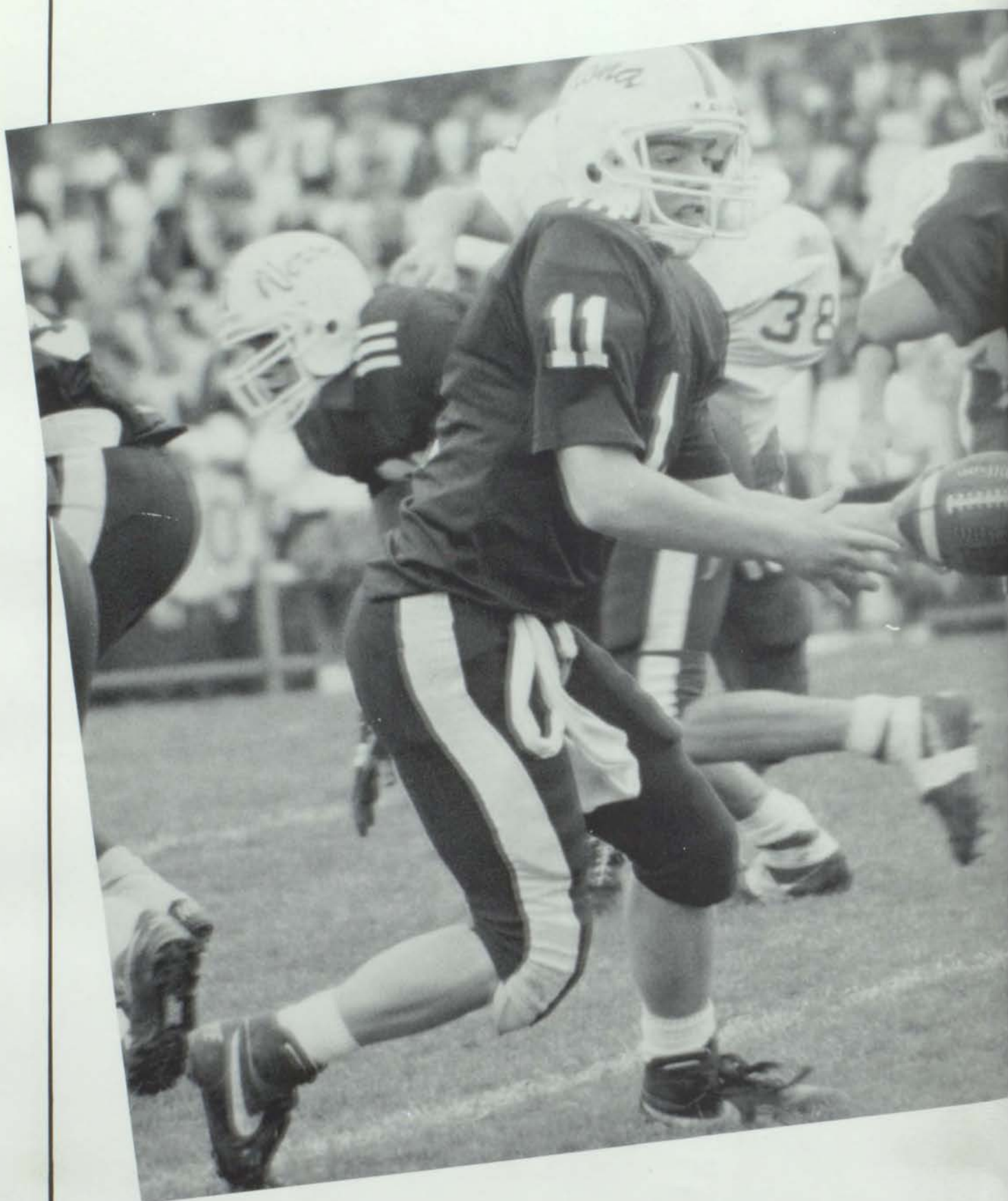


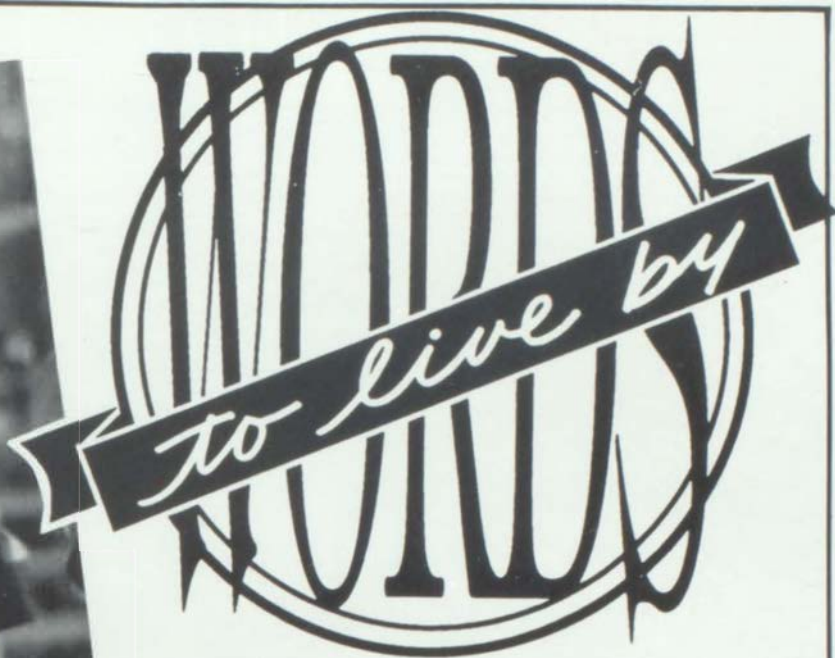
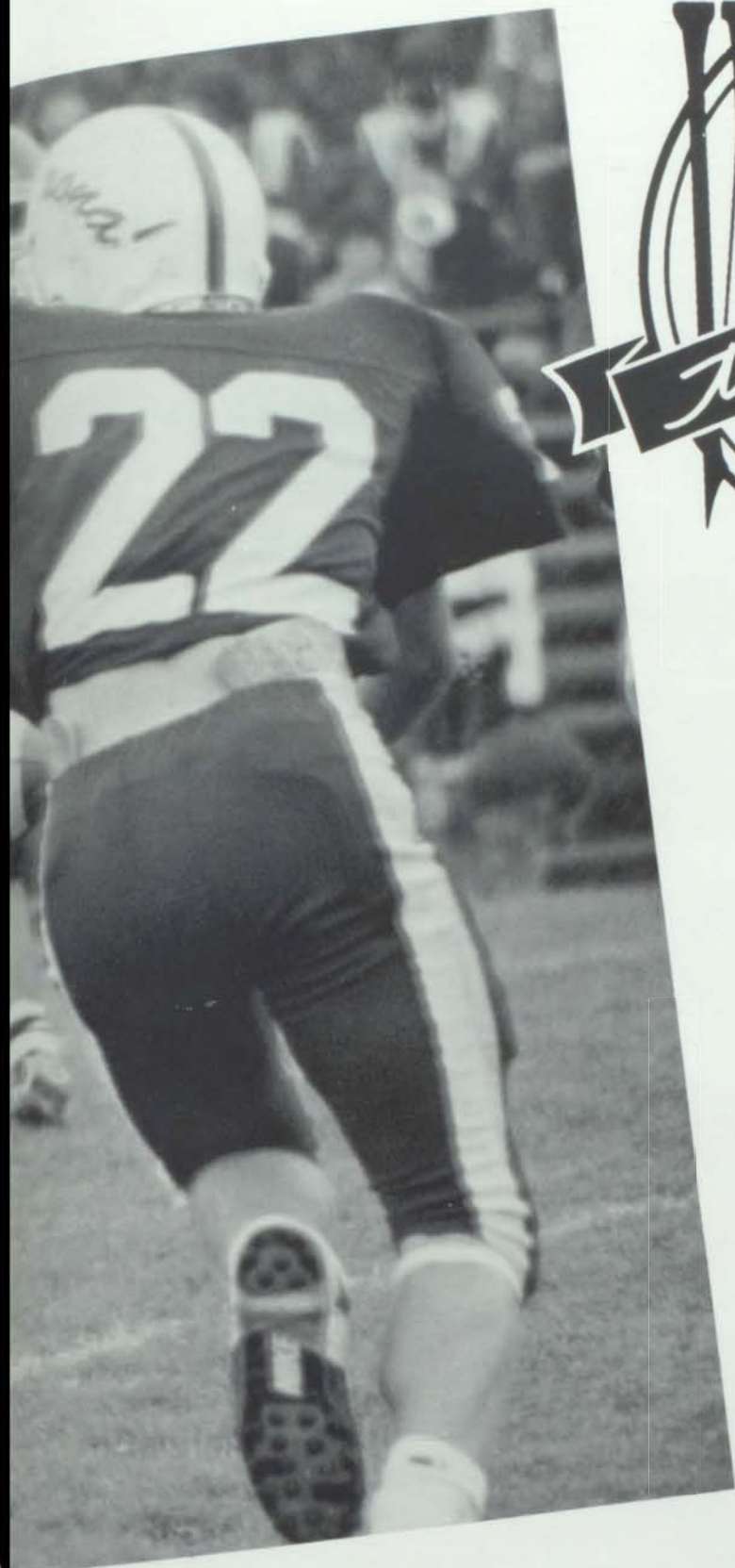


INTERNATIONAL WEEKEND

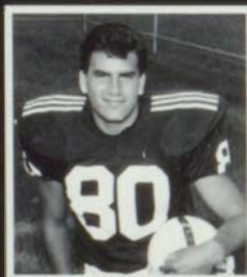

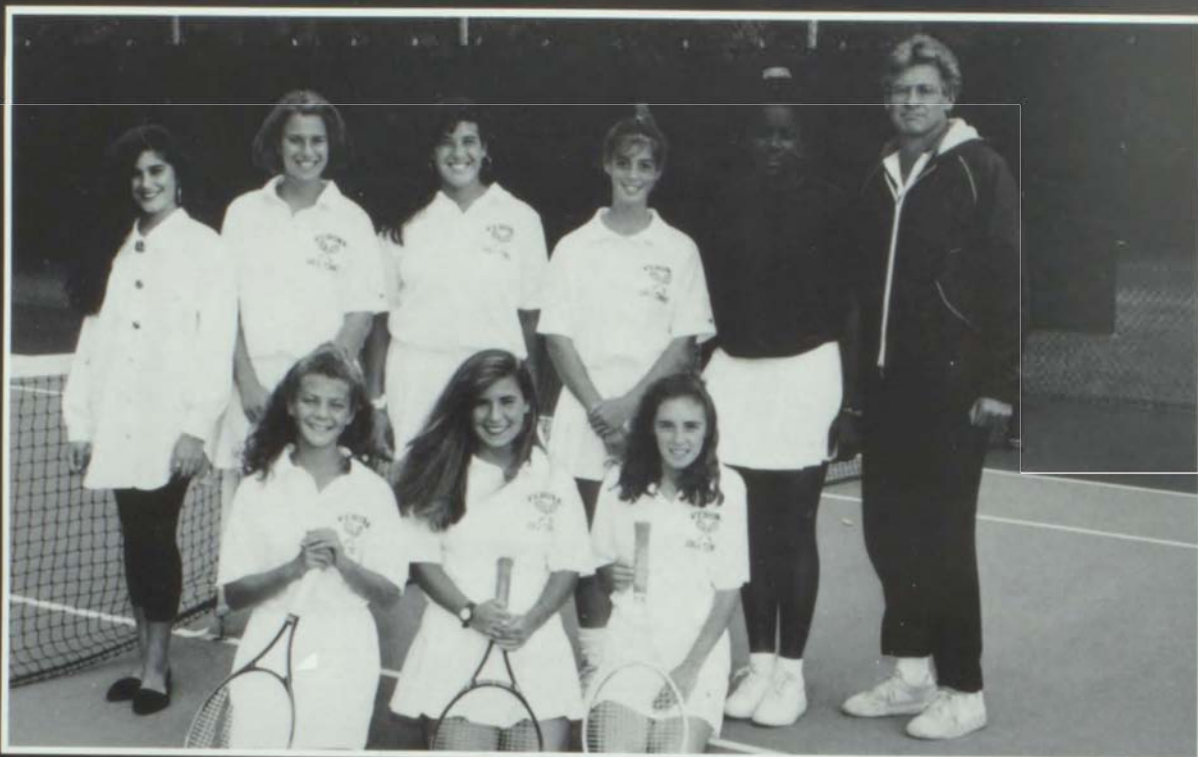

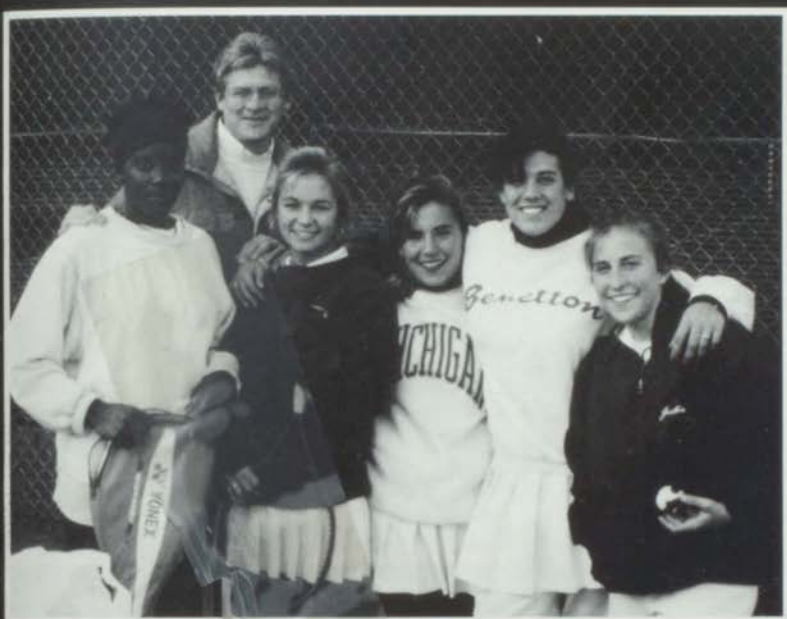

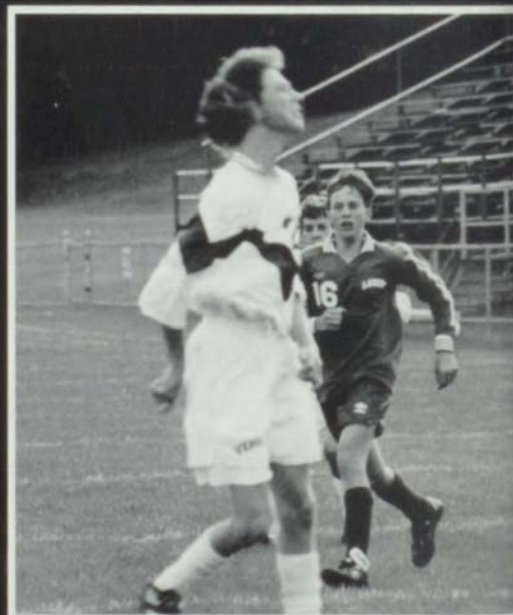

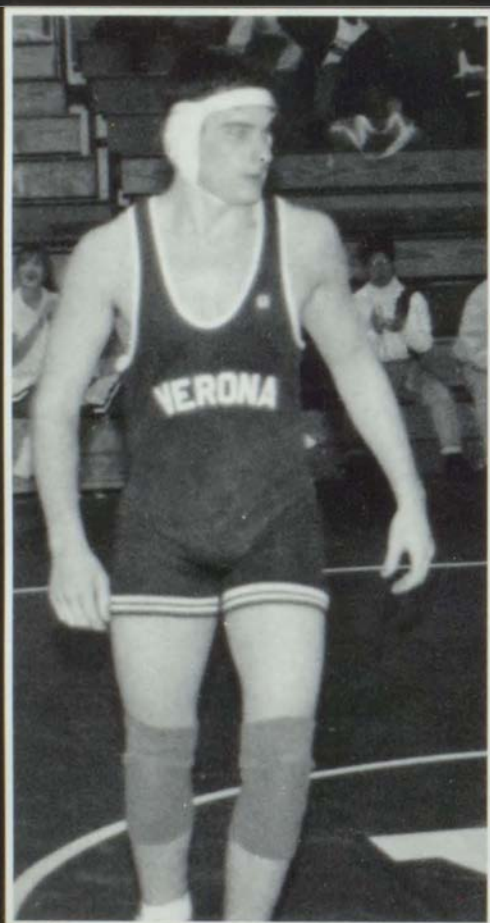

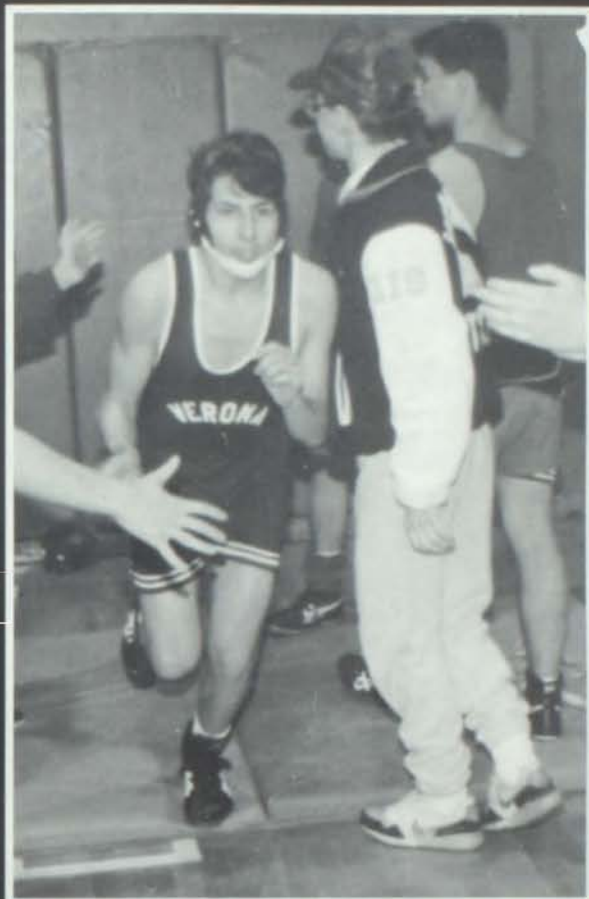
