But for those with no drums, no plane, no access to a laundromat and nowhere else to go, "We'll see you back in "The Lot!"








Well. . .we tried.

Under the supervision of Coach


Kaplanovich, those team members not committed to other sports spent most of the winter, spring and summer prior to the '92 season enduring a demanding weight training regimen.



Over twenty girls came to the first day of practice. Their efforts had succeeded.





The Boys team finished the year with a 7-7 record, a great improvement on the prior year's winless season. The Girls team finished with a 7-6 record.



The ultimate reward is getting his hand raised by the referees after a match, but if he fails, the VHS wrestler will always know he tried!


