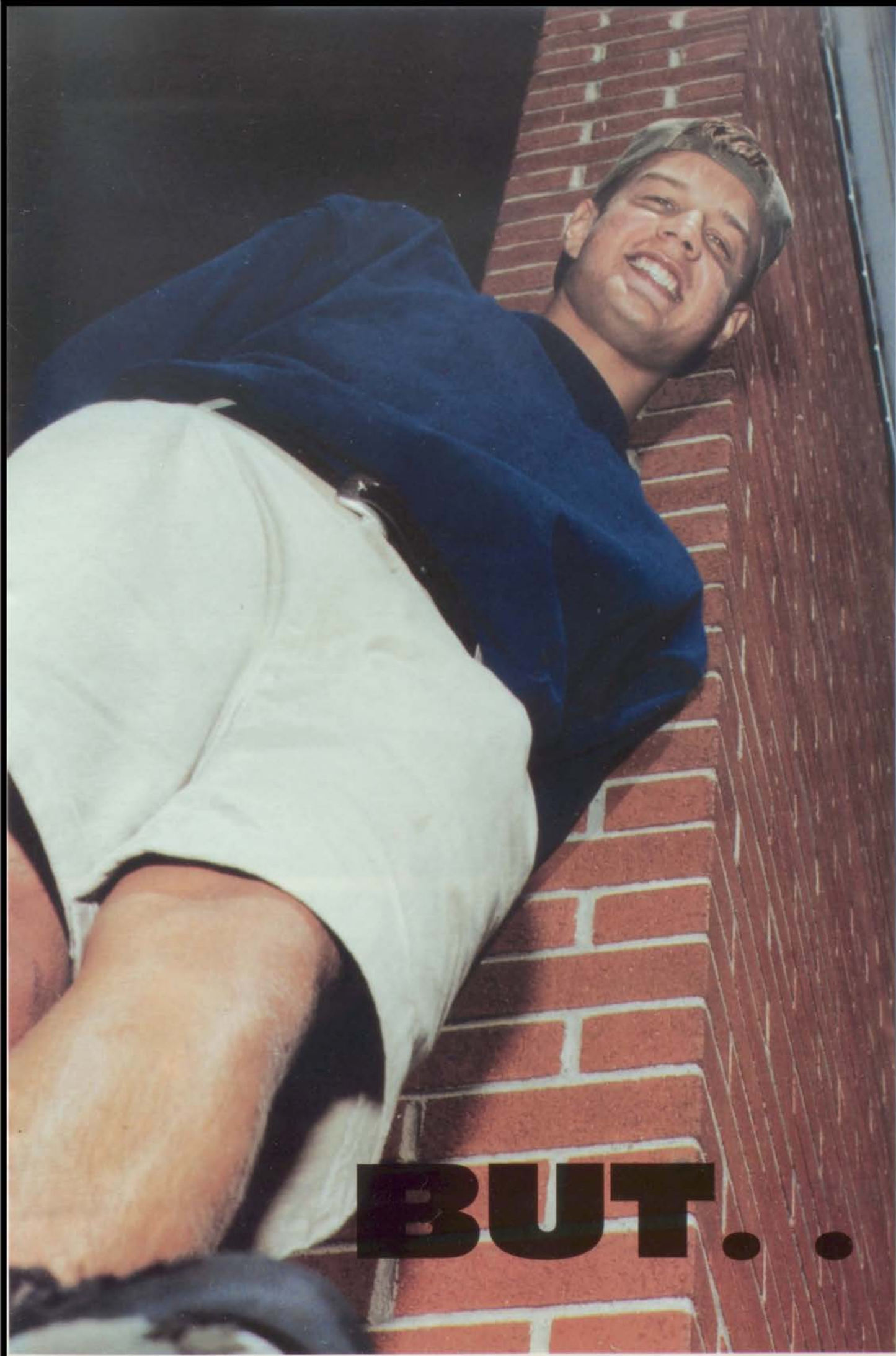


# Once upon a time...

# Friends

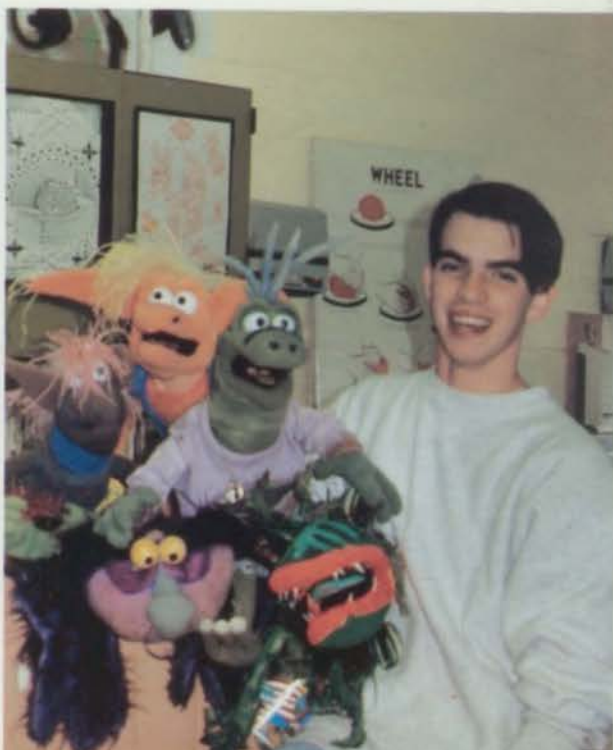

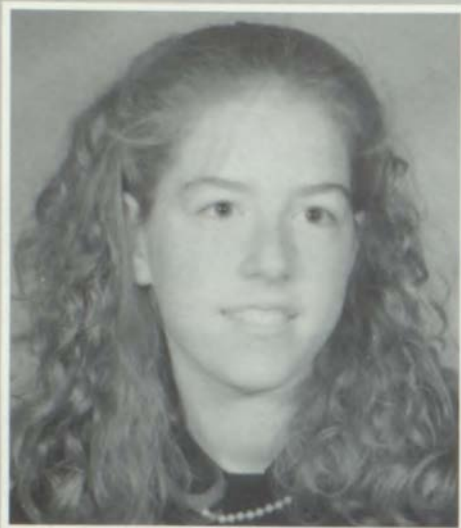

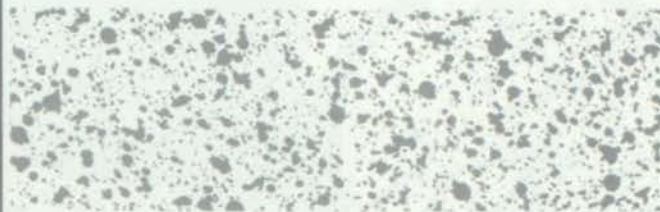

## Weighting for the Season

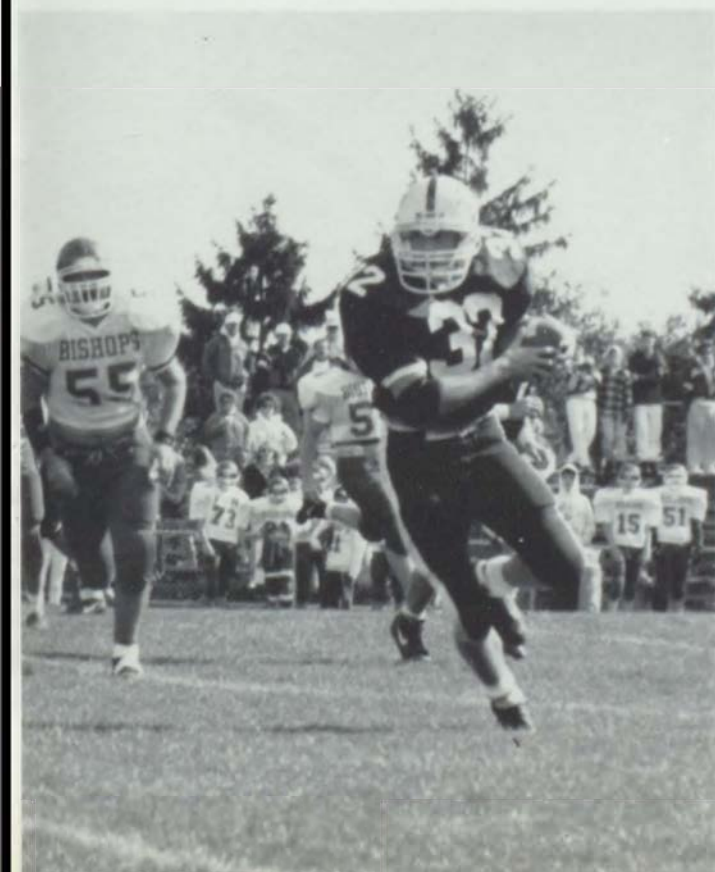
**A**ccording to junior lineman Dave Bussin, the success of this year's team all started in the weight room.

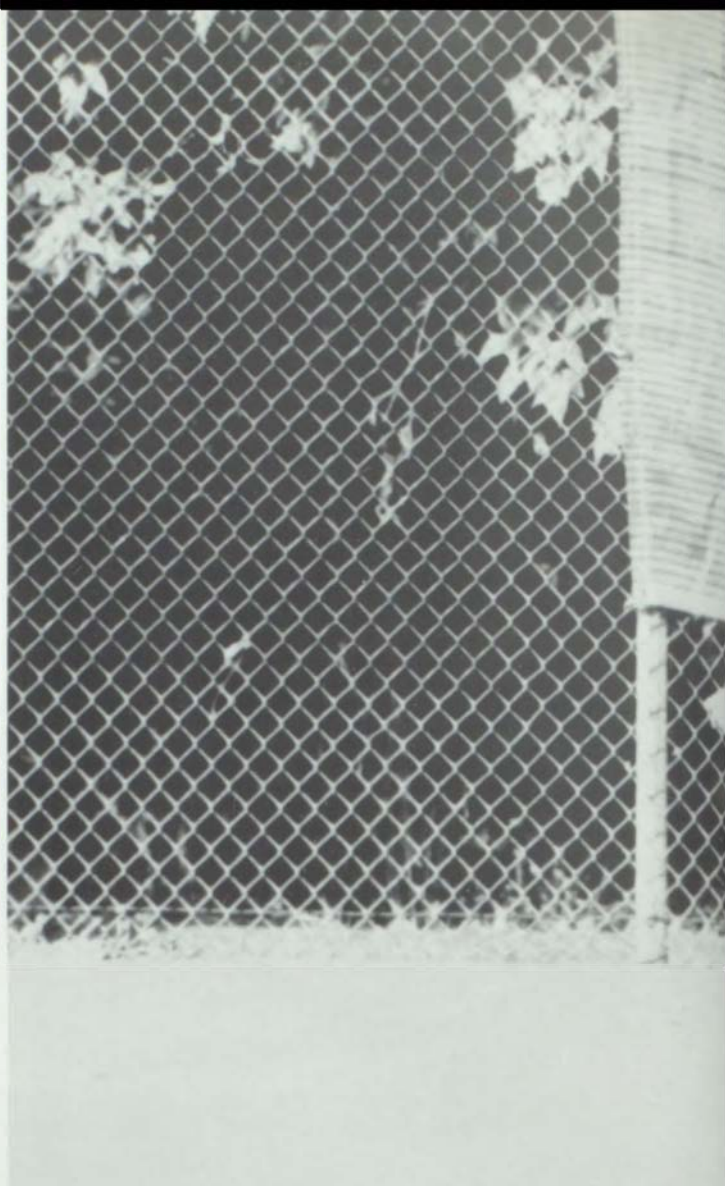


# Bennigan's Anyone?
