A recent cafeteria poll was taken asking students of their views of the new changes in the cafeteria food provided. In the survey, students

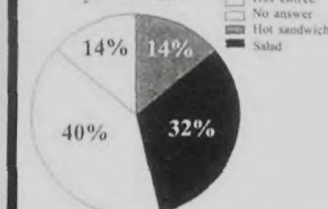
responded to questions asking their opinion about prices, variety of options, menu changes, and favorite food.

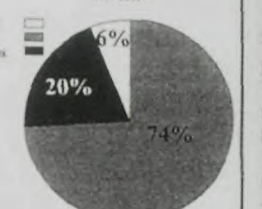
responders were not afraid to speak their mind and wrote, "Bring back the trans-fats," and "Go back to junk food!"

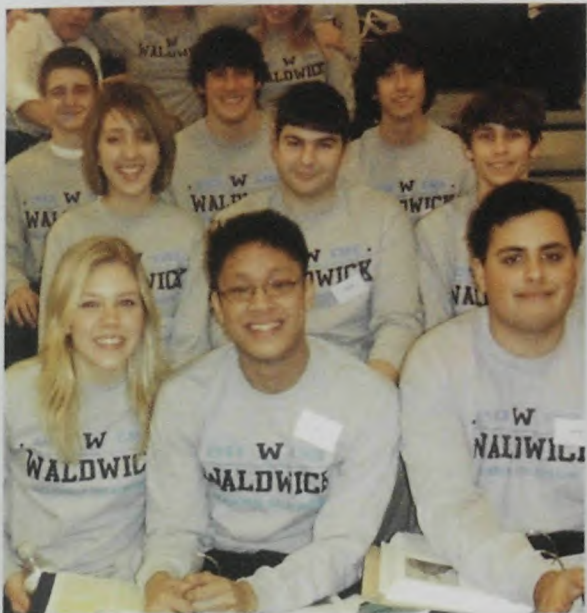
Academic Decathlon

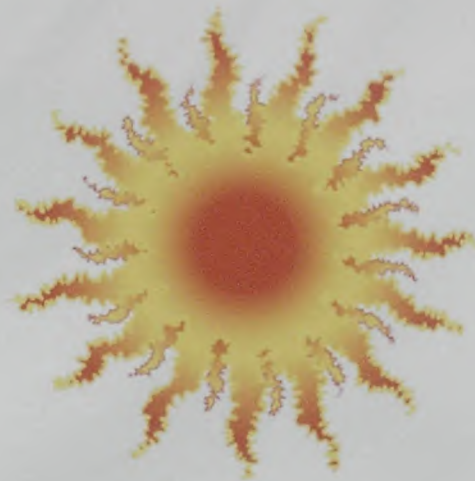

Members of this organization are trained three times and make three elementary school visits. Topics cover transition to middle and high school, conflict resolution, sportsmanship, bullying and substance abuse.

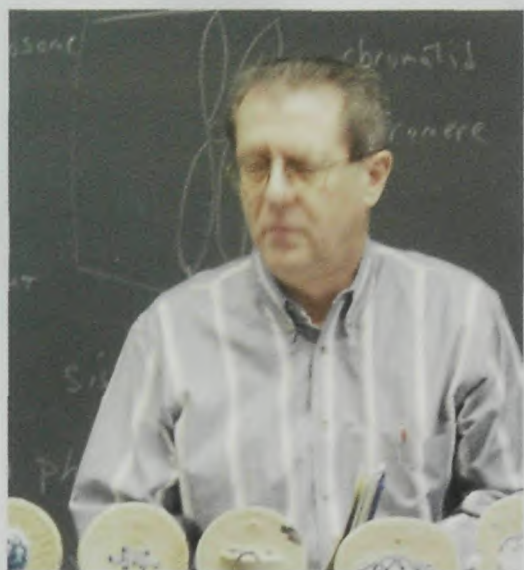
It is required that students be nominated and participate in an application process prior to being accepted.

PAAC is an organization that tries to improve the environment.

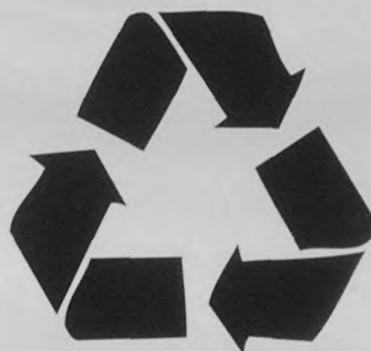

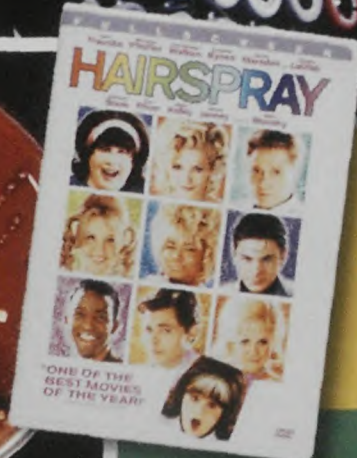

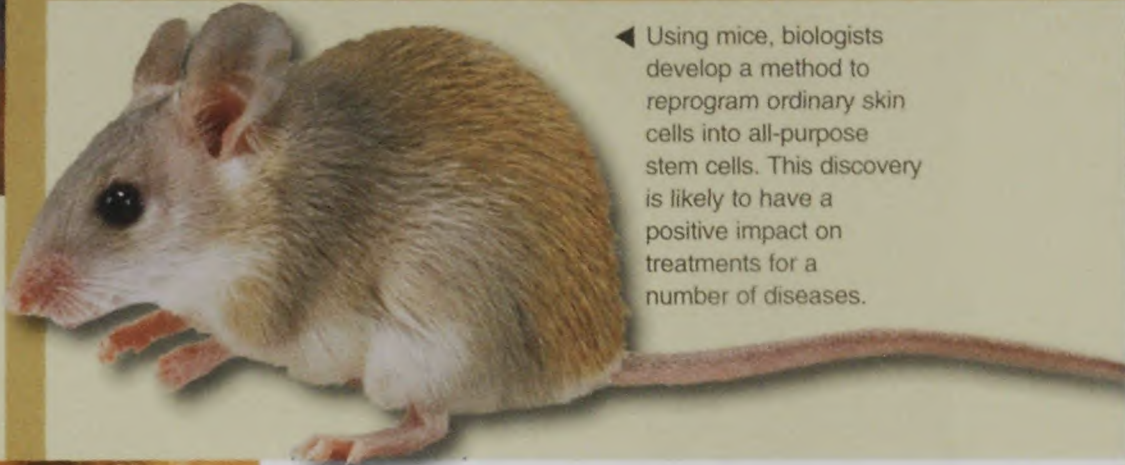

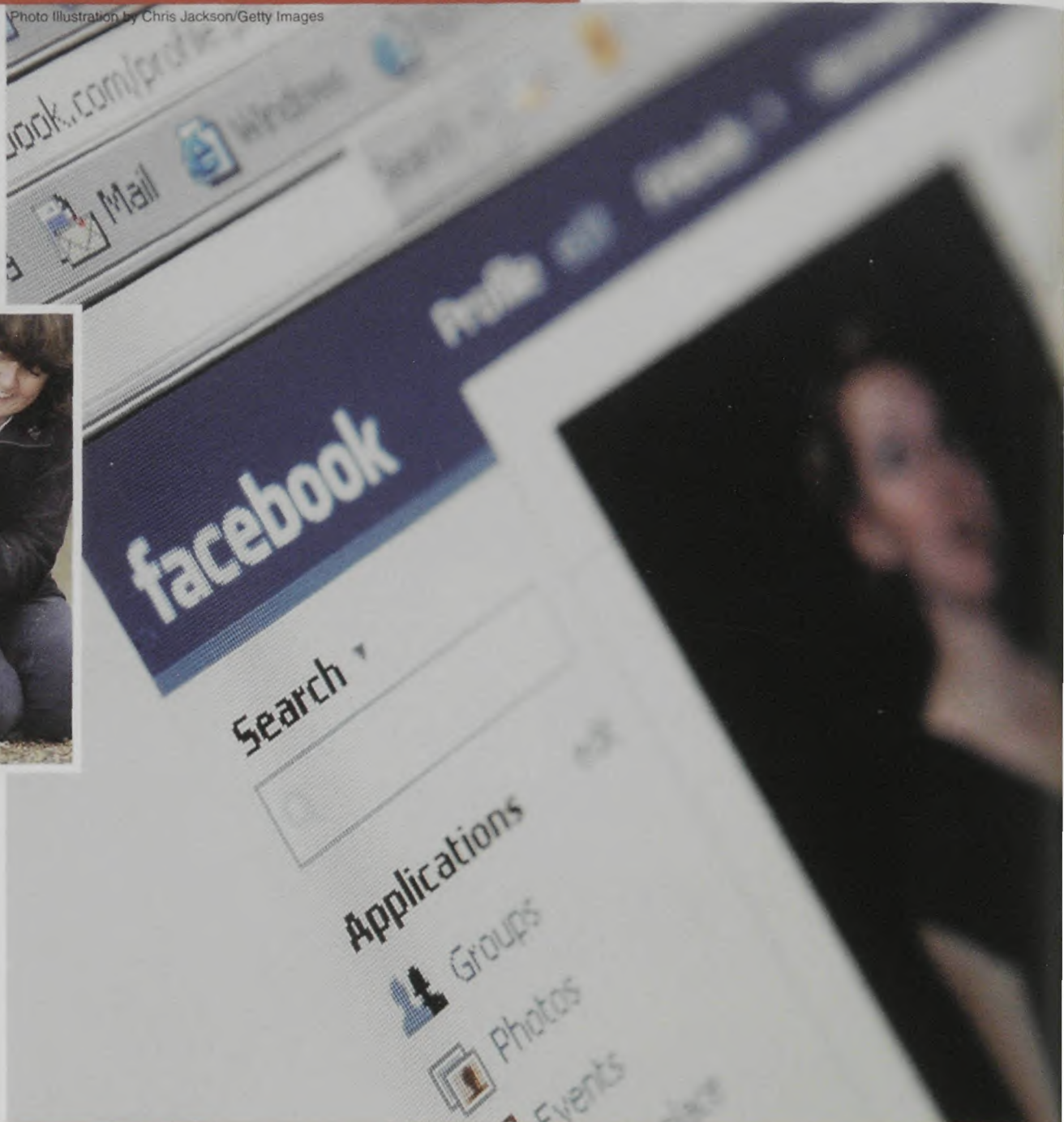

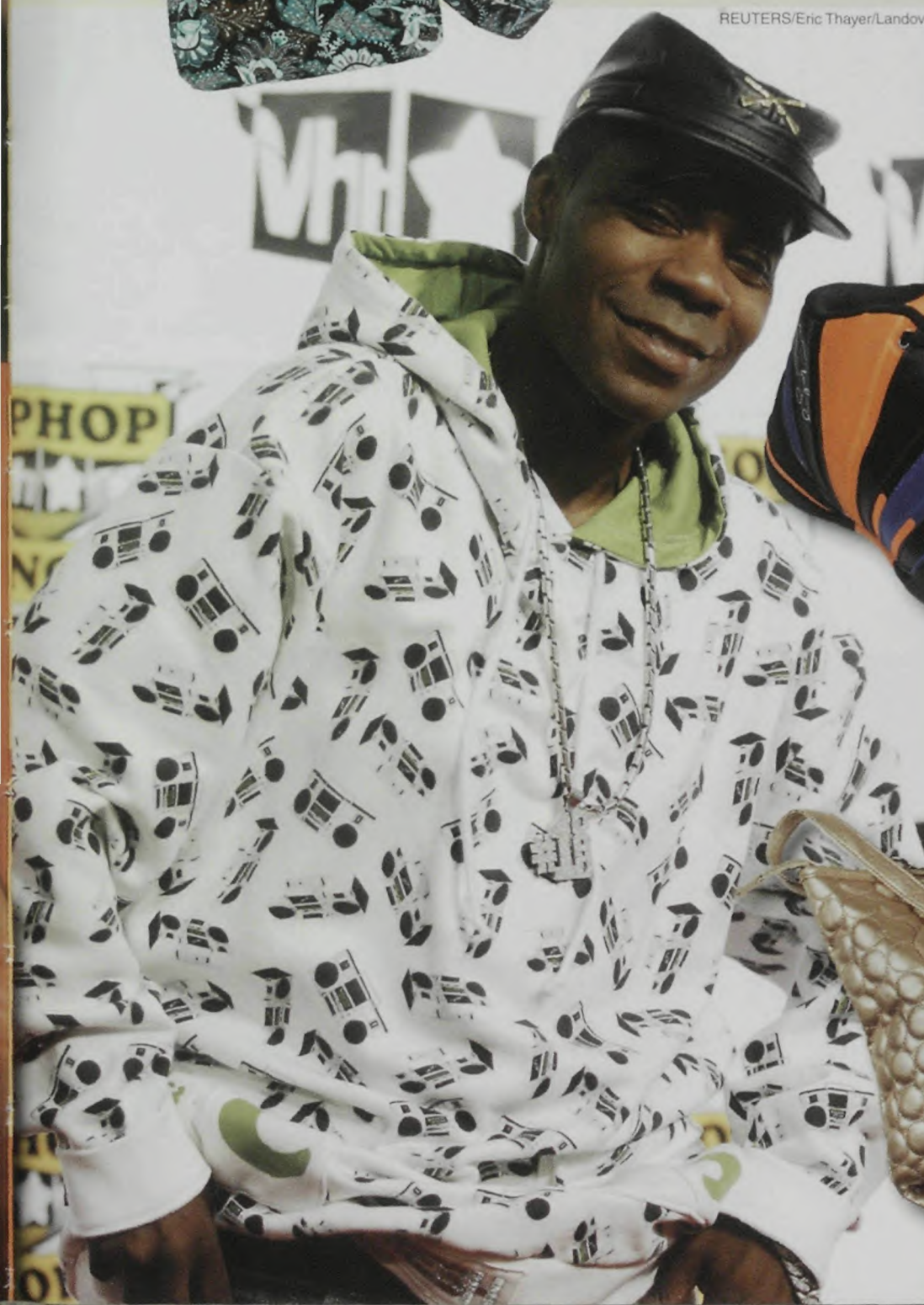

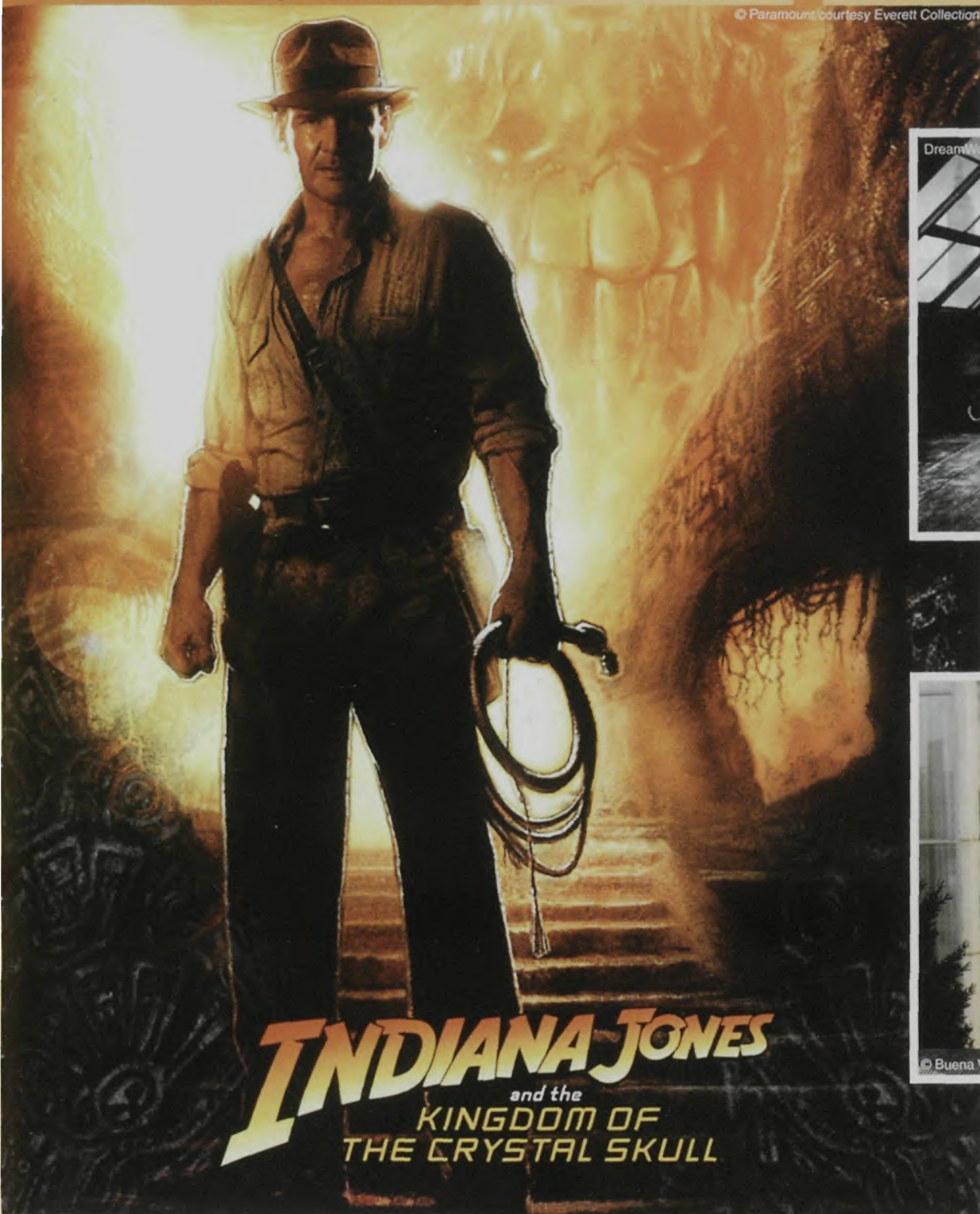

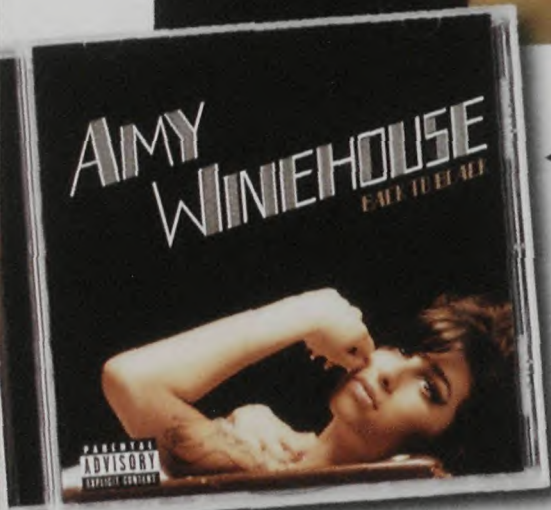

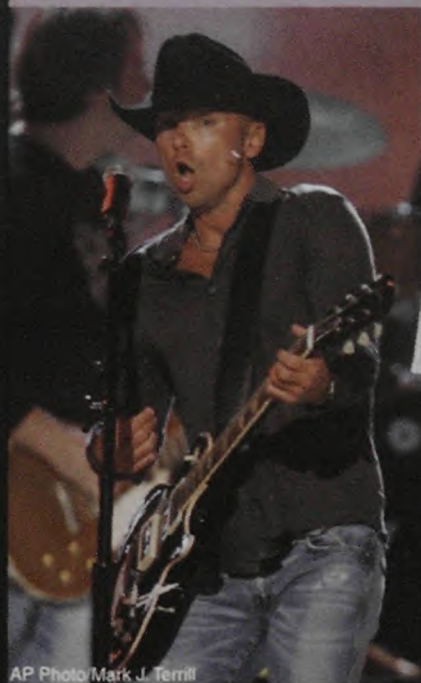

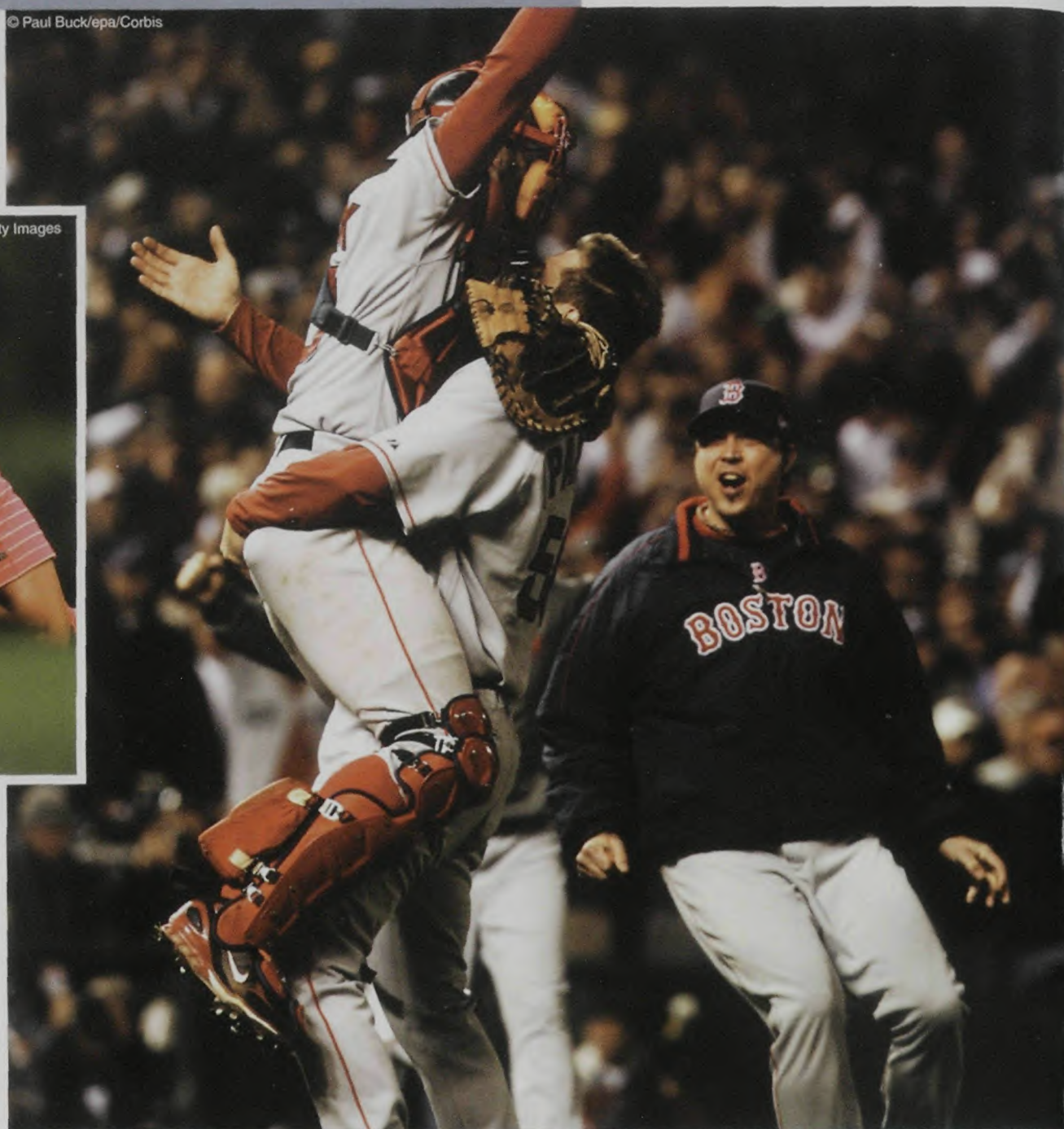

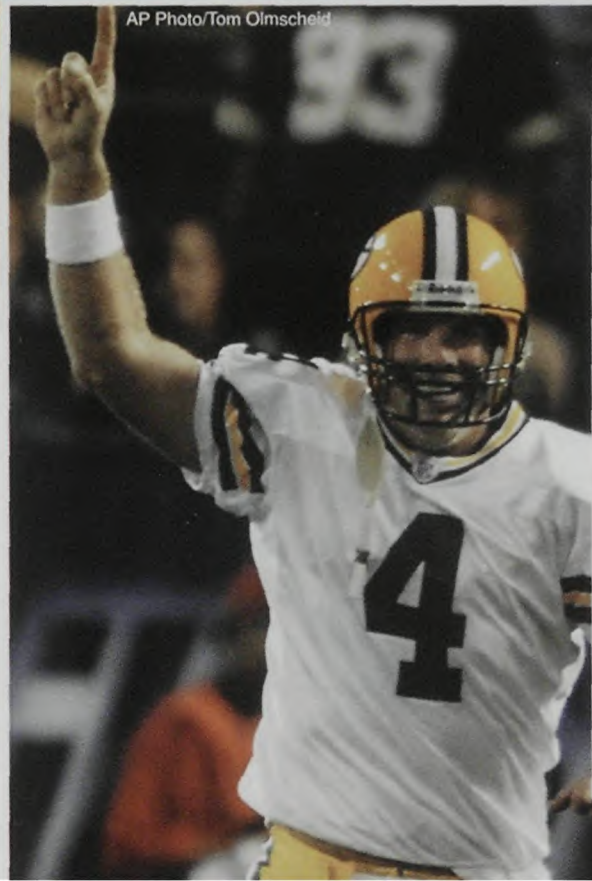

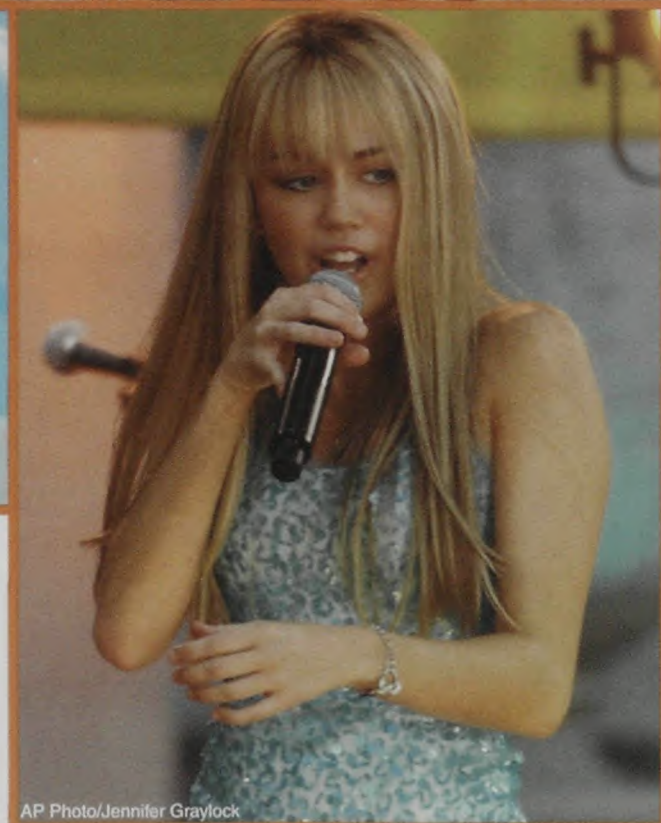
